Program description

The programme aims to contribute to economic and climate change resilience of the value chains cashew, cocoa, maize and livestock (cattle, goats, sheep) to food security, increased income, and employment in the 79 African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) countries under Post-Cotonou agreement.

Specific objective

• Develop and enhance the capacities of actors along ACP agriculture value chains to attract finance and investment, in particular towards low-emissions and climate resilient practices and value chains.

Expected results:

- i) Capacities of agriculture value chain actors notably family farmers and MSMEs, to attract finance and investment are enhanced;
- **ii)** Competitiveness, upgrading and viability of ACP agricultural commodities VC in terms of value addition, technology content and conformance to international standards are strengthened;
- **iii)** Integration of family farmers and MSMEs into national, regional and global value chains is strengthened;







- iv) Trade and export competitiveness of ACP agricultural products is improved;
- **v)** An enabling environment is set up for fostering access to finance of ACP value chain actors, including through value chain finance;
- vi) Nutrition-sensitive agriculture value chains are promoted;
- **vii)** Sustainable agricultural practices are encouraged, and environmental climate change resilience is improved.

Governance

A Project Steering Committee (PSC) co-chaired by EU and the OACPS Secretariat will review progress in the implementation of the programme and provide strategic guidance and recommendations.
